### About the Internship

The **Weathervane Theatre Internship Program (WIP)** is a total immersion experience of practical theatre arts training and networking. WIPs live, work, learn, and play alongside the professional actors and staff from the Broadway and regional theatre communities and perform in original children's theatre and Mainstage productions throughout the season. A rigorous schedule, WIPs increase their stamina, performance longevity, and work ethic rehearsing one show during the day while performing another at night. WIP participants may choose to earn up to **9 Equity Membership Candidate (EMC) credits**. Notable WIP alum: 2018 Tony Award winner Ari'el Stachel.

### Patchwork Players

- WIPs constitute the entire company of the Patchwork Players, Weathervane's Theatre for Young Audiences (TYA) Programming.
- In addition to performing, WIPs will also devise the script for *Families are Like Fudge*.
- Patchwork Players productions are presented twice a week - once in house at Weathervane and once on the road in a venue in New Hampshire. WIPs get firsthand tour experience and participate in Meet & Greets prior to every performance.

### Mainstage Experience

- **PERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITIES:** Cast in at least three Mainstage productions and earning **9 EMC credits**.
- **NEW FOR 2019:** Intern Mainstage Production. In addition to three Mainstage productions WIPs will perform and be heavily featured in the Intern Mainstage Production of *Spring Awakening in Concert*.
- **EDUCATION:** Workshops in singing, acting, and dancing to be provided by professional actors and staff from the Broadway and regional communities.
- **NETWORKING:** Work alongside top creative teams. Directors in the 2019 season include top industry professionals from regional theatres and Broadway including a **Tony Award winner**.
- **PRACTICAL THEATRE EXPERIENCE:** Shop hours as well as pre/post-show duties enable WIPs to work with top industry professionals in stage management, props, costume design, and set design. If not cast in a production, WIPs will serve on stage crew for said production.
- *Upon arrival WIPs will re-audition for casting in both Mainstage and Patchwork Productions.*

### Tuition

A payment of \$2200\* for the season (June 17th - August 31st) covers room and board and meals six days a week (Monday - Saturday).
